Discharge planning helps ensure that the same quality care is provided throughout the treatment process in order to prevent re-hospitalization or further illness.

Our approach to discharge planning begins at the initial point of hospitalization. Clinicians work collaboratively with the patient, the doctors/nurses, family/caregiver and claims staff throughout the transition from the hospital to home or facility.

Appropriate medical support is planned and executed at every step of the process, to demonstrate compassionate care while optimizing recovery. For example, when surgery is approved by utilization review, our nurse will expedite the scheduling, durable medical equipment, post-operative therapies, admission to skilled nursing facility, home health care, and other support services.
